**2022-2023 Dress Code Policy**

**Purpose:** The purpose of Standard School Attire (SSA) is to help create a distraction free learning environment where all students can receive an excellent education. The 2022-2023 Dress Code Policy was developed in conjunction with our students and piloted during the Spring 2022 Semester. We expect all students to fully comply with the Whites Creek High School Dress Code beginning Monday, August 8<sup>th</sup>, until the last day of school, Thursday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Dress Code Do's**

- Students may wear any color collared shirt with short or long sleeves.
- Students may wear any Whites Creek High School approved "Spirit Wear" shirt.
  - Students may wear denim or sweatpants with approved "Spirit Wear" shirts, **ONLY. The "Spirit Wear" shirt must always be visible during the school day. Skin should not be seen at any time through pants or tops.**
- Students may wear navy blue, black, khaki/brown, and grey colored shorts, pants, capri pants, skirts, skorts, dresses, or jumpers.
  - All dresses, shorts, skirts, or skorts must be longer than the longest fingertip.
- Students may wear a hoodie with school appropriate language and/or message.
- Students may wear a single blazer, suit jacket, vest, sweater, or cardigan as a garment that may be worn over an appropriate collared SSA top.
- Students are encouraged to always wear their pants at their waistline.

#### **Dress Code Don'ts**

- Students may not wear sleepwear or bike shorts at any time during the school day.
- Students may not wear leggings or tights without a dress on top. (The dress must be longer than the longest fingertip).
- Students may not wear a hood in the building.
- Students may not wear any type of head covering, except for religious belief.
- Students may not wear clothing or jewelry that display drugs, alcohol or tobacco products, gang-related or sex-related words or images.
